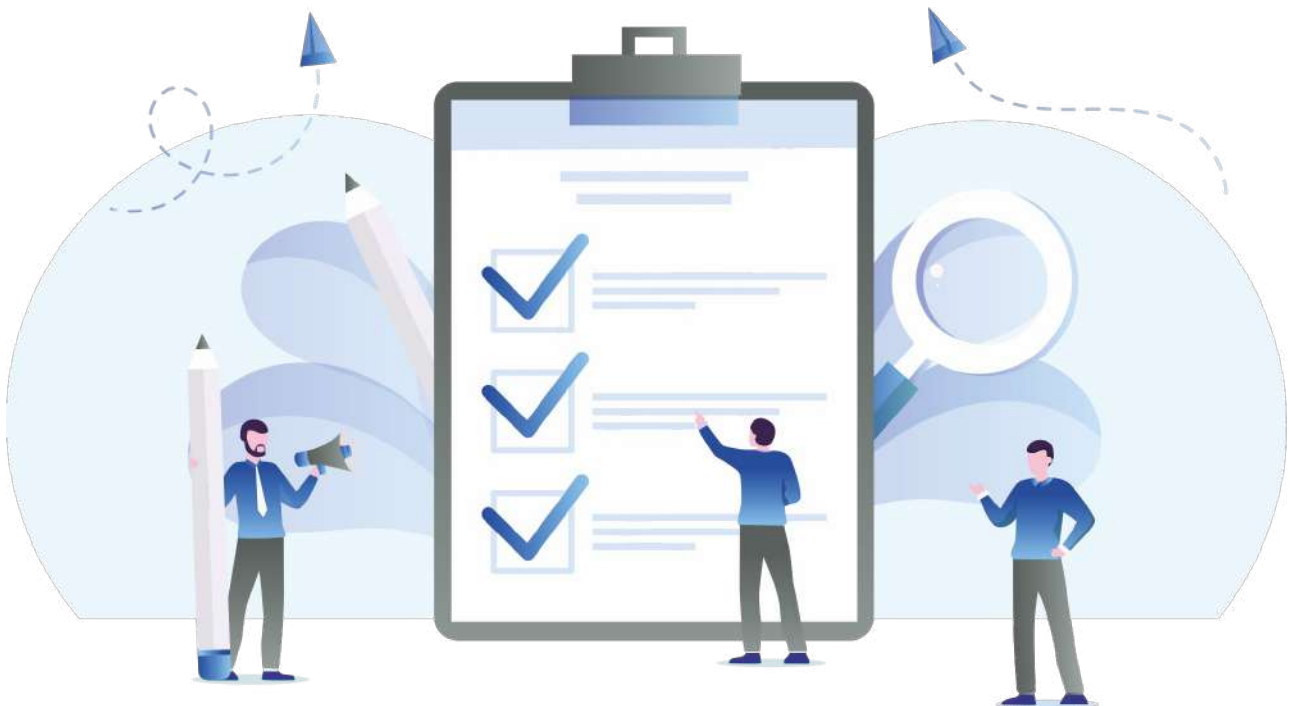

Applicant's Personal Details

> Passport

 Required  Original

Provide colour copies of the pages of your current passport showing your photo, personal details, and passport issue and expiry dates.

> National Identity Document

 Recommend  Original

All applicants who hold a National Identity Card must provide a valid copy of it.

Evidence of Change of Name

> Marriage Certificate or Deed Poll Certificate (Proof of change of name)

 Recommend  Original

If anyone in the application has changed his or her name, certified copies of documents verifying the name change. This might include a marriage or deed poll certificate or a certified copy of evidence of the name change which may include: • change of name documents from an Australian Registry of Births, Deaths and Marriages, or the relevant overseas authority • documents that show other names you have been known by.

Character Documents

> Australian Federal Police Check

 Recommend  Original

DO NOT arrange the police checks until advised by the Department of Home Affairs (DHA). Department will advise you if they require your Police Certificates. Provide an Australian police certificate (AFP) if you have spent a total of 12 months or more in Australia in the last 10 years since you turned 16. Only complete disclosure National Police Certificates issued by the Australian Federal Police is accept. Standard disclosure certificates or national police certificates issued by Australian state or territory police will not be Acceptable. For immigration purposes, Australian police certificates are valid for 12 months from the date of issue.

> Overseas Police Clearance Certificate

 Recommend  Original

DO NOT arrange the police checks until advised by the Department of Home Affairs (DHA). Department will advise you if they require your Police Certificates. If required, please provide: 1) An overseas police certificate from every country, including your home country, where you spent a total of 12 months or more in the last 10 years since you turned 16. 2) Military service records or discharge papers if you served in the armed forces of any country.

Visa Documents

Provide documents to support your application for the visa. Include details of any immigration matters you are awaiting the outcome of, including: • visa applications • merit review proceedings • judicial review proceedings • ministerial intervention requests Or, if you are applying for the visa because you are arranging your departure from Australia, provide details of: • when you intend to leave • where you are going • your current passport or other travel document • your ticket
