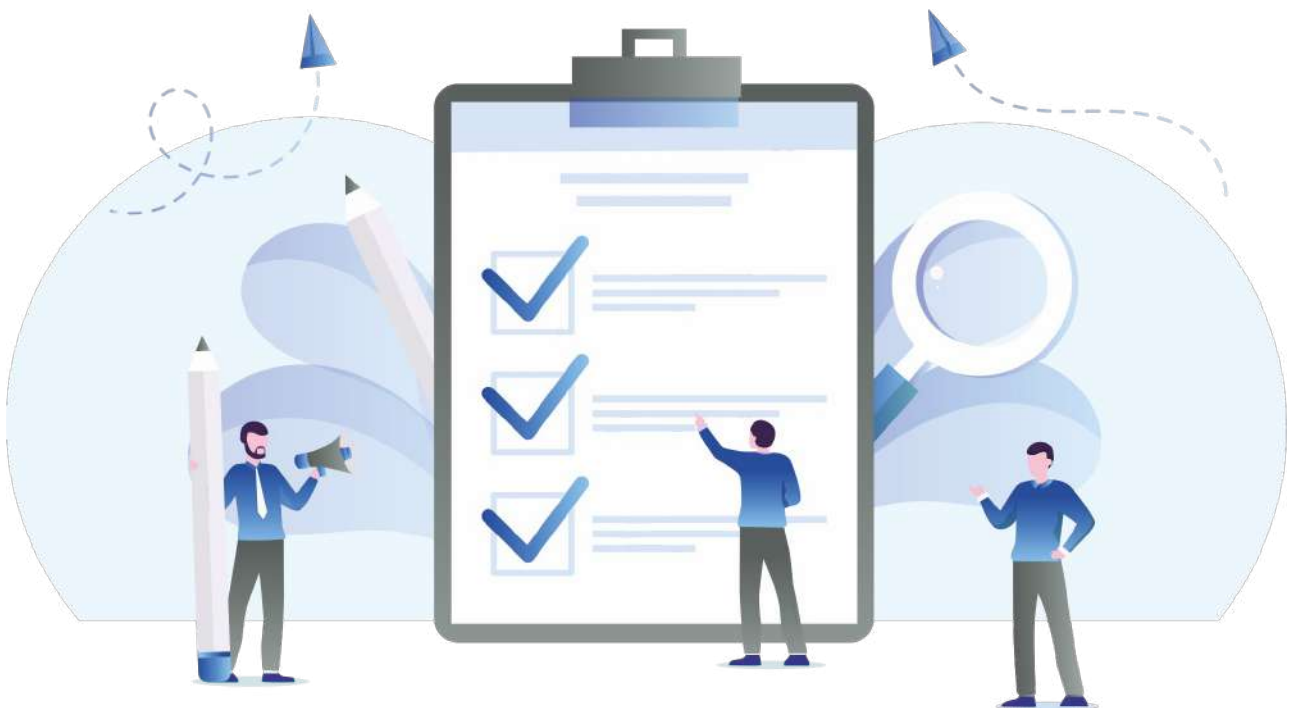

Applicant's Personal Details

> Passport

 Required  Certified

Provide the pages of your current passport showing your photo, personal details, and passport issue and expiry dates.

> National Identity Document

 Recommend  Original

Copy of National Identity Card (both sides) if you have one

> Change of Name documents

 Recommend  Original

Submit the documents that provides evidence of name change. Documents may serve as an evidence include: • a marriage or divorce certificate • change of name documents from an Australian Registry of Births, Deaths and Marriages, or the relevant overseas authority • documents that show other names you have been known by

Financial Documents

> Financial Documents

 Required  Original

Provide evidence you have enough money for your stay in Australia. Contact the agent to get details about the exact funds that you may need to show in your case. Proofs of access to funds can include bank statements, credit card limits, personal savings, etc. You must also show that you have enough money to buy a ticket to leave Australia at the end of your stay, or that you already have the ticket.

Health Insurance

> Health Insurance

 Required  Original

Provide evidence of adequate health insurance for you and your family members for the first 12 months of your stay in Australia. This can be Overseas Visitors Health Cover (OVHC) premium or another health insurance product from Australia or your home country that provides a similar level of cover.

Genuine Temporary Entrant

> Statement of Purpose

 Required  Original

Write a personal statement addressing the Genuine Temporary Entry requirement. If you are not comfortable writing it in English, you can write your statement in your own language and submit a translated copy with your application. In your written statement, provide evidence or information about circumstances in your home country, ties to your home country or country of residence and incentive to return. This could include:

- evidence of immediate family members in your home country
- your visa or residence status in your home country and your right to return
- proof of property or other significant assets in your home country
- a return air ticket
- a letter from your employer confirming your leave

◎ Character Documents

> Australian Federal Police Check

 Required  Original

Provide a copy of your Australian Federal Police check. This is generally required when you have spent a total of 12 months in Australia after turning 16 years of age.

> Overseas Police Clearance Certificate

 Recommend  Original

You may be required to provide a police certificate (also called a penal clearance certificate) from every country you lived in. It will usually be if you are over 17 and lived in any of the listed countries, including Australia, for at least 12 months in the past 10 years. Police certificates are valid for 12 months from the issue date. They must cover the time you turned 16 up to the issue date OR the whole time you were in the country.

> Additional information

 Recommend  Original

There are additional documents required for the dependents aged 6 or younger included on your application. These documents may change depending upon personal circumstances. Please consult a migration agent for more information about the documents required in your circumstances.
