Visa Application Forms

> Application for a protection visa [Form 866]

Required Original

You must include these documents in your application: • the online application form in ImmiAccount, or • Form 866 Application for a protection visa You must provide all relevant documents and attach the relevant fees to pay the visa application charge when you apply.

> UNHCR disclosure consent form

If anyone in the application has changed his or her name, certified copies of documents verifying the name change. This might include a marriage or deed poll certificate or a certified copy of evidence of the name change.

> Claims for Protection



You must answer all the questions on the application form about your claims for protection. If you don't have enough space, you can submit additional information and attach it to the application. When preparing your claims for protection, you should think about the following questions: • What country are you seeking protection from? • Why did you leave that country? • Why are you unable to return to that country? • Have you experienced harm in that country? If so, what is the harm you have experienced? • Who caused the harm to you? • What do you fear might happen to you if you return to that country? • Why do you think this will happen to you if you return? • Is there an area in that country where you would not be harmed? Would you be able to relocate there? • Are the authorities in your country able to protect you? • When did you leave your home country? • How did you get to Australia? We will use this information to assess whether you engage Australia's protection obligations. If you are registered with the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees (UNHCR) and have been assessed by the UNHCR, you need to give us consent to contact them about your claims.



Marriage Certificate or Divorce Certificate or Separation Document or Statutory Declaration or Death Certificate

Evidence of your relationship with your spouse/de facto partner include a copy of your marriage certificate, Death certificate, Divorce Certificate, Separation Document or Statutory Declaration or other evidence of family composition.

> Relationship History

Relationship History: - how, when and where you first met - how the relationship developed - when you moved in together, got engaged or married - what you do together - time you spent apart - significant events in the relationship - your plans for the future

> Marriage Photographs

Evidence of Marriage Photographs performing the ceremony.



> Evidence of Sharing Finances

Finances Show how you and your partner share financial matters. You could give: - joint mortgage or lease documents - joint loan documents for major assets like homes, cars or major appliances - joint bank account statements - household bills in both names

For every dependant 18 years old or younger who are applying with you, provide: - Copies of birth certificates or the family book showing the names of both parents of all your dependent children - copies of the adoption paper, if applicable.

Relationship Document

> Relationship to the child documents





You will need to give DHA: • birth certificate • marriage certificates • death certificates • adoption certificates • family status certificates or family books if officially issued and maintained If you are a step-parent, you must provide documents to show all of the following: • you were the partner of the child's parent • you have legal parental responsibility for the child • the child's biological or adoptive parentage • that the child is younger than 18 years of age
